


The Hive and the Honeybee

Developed with the help of beekeepers from across the United States, The Hive and the Honeybee is a free full-text digital archive of selected books and journal volumes from one of the world's most comprehensive apicultural libraries, the E. F. Phillips Collection at the Albert R. Mann Library of Cornell University. This growing online archive offers works chosen for their historical importance and usefulness to beekeepers today. Recent additions include rare gems such as the 1623 edition of Charles Butler's *The Feminine Monarchie* and early volumes of the *American Bee Journal*, the first English language bee magazine, which featured contributions by L. L. Langstroth, A. I Root and other key leaders in 19th and early 20th century American beekeeping.

The online Hive collection will continue to grow as funding allows, with the goal of eventually offering ever major pre-1925 beekeeping work in the English language.
